Take the CTE Outcomes Survey!

What: The CTE Outcomes Survey (CTEOS) contacts our community college Career Education students after they enter the workforce to learn about their employment, career and college experiences.

Why: It is important to know how students are doing in their careers. This valuable information helps us understand our successes, areas for improvement, and it is used by the State Chancellor's office to measure the effectiveness of Career Ed programs for promotion and funding. **It is vital that students participate!**

Who: Career Education students who completed 9 units or earned a Career Education Degree or Certificate and are no longer attending Community College.

When: The survey is sent one-and-a-half to two years after the Career Education student has stopped attending community college. The survey runs February through August annually.

How: The survey is sent by email. Follow up, if needed, is by text message, and then a phone call. Santa Rosa Junior College manages the survey for the State. **Students should make sure their college has their current contact information!**
