Outcomes Survey!

What: The CTE Outcomes Survey (CTEOS) reaches out to all community college Career Technical Education (CTE) students after they enter the workforce, asking how satisfied they were with their CTE program and how their education affected their employment outcomes.

Why: Your college wants to know how you're doing, and the State Chancellor's office wants to measure the effectiveness of CTE programs. This information, in turn, affects your college's funding, which affects what programs they can offer in the future. It's important to your college that you participate!

How: The survey is sent one to two years after the CTE student completed their award, graduated, transferred, or stopped attending classes at their community college. Santa Rosa Junior College manages the survey for ALL colleges. Starting in February, the survey is sent **first by email and then by text**. If you do not respond to those, you will get a call by a phone bank at Cal State Fullerton. You can find their phone number and more information on the CTEOS website: www.cteos.org.
